

With this feature, you do not need to call or send an email to get the latest updates on your cargo. All you need to do is subscribe to either web and/or email notification, and receive daily container movements (Gate In, Load, Discharge & Gate Out) updates through our web platform or straight to your inbox.

Step 1: Go to Maersk.com and click the Account icon




Step 2: Select 'Manage Subscriptions'

Step 3: Select which events you'd like to receive notifications and open the drop down



Step 4: Select which channels you'd like to receive container movements notifications by ticking the box beside email and web.

You may also set criteria for shipments on which you would like to receive notifications through **filters**. Additionally, you may opt to receive notifications only for shipments where your company plays a role through **Party roles** section. Kindly refer to slide 5 to learn more about each role.








### Subscribing to Email Notifications




This email notification provides you with a daily summary of your container movements. Once subscribed, you will start receiving updates straight to your inbox after a 24-hour period.
















## Subscribing to Web Notifications



This web notification provides you with an online summary of your shipment details. It's another channel to get visibility for Gate-in, Load, Discharge and Gate-out movements. Once subscribed, you will start to access the information online after a 24-hour period, and filter the updates based on shipment level and/or shipment date.

## Role descriptions



#### Booked by:

Party who submits the booking request.

#### Price Owner:

Party who negotiates the rates.

#### Outward forwarder:

Agent who facilitates the export formalities.

#### Shipper:

Seller/exporter of the cargo.

#### First notify party:

Party who is informed of the arrival of the cargo.

#### Inward forwarder:

Agent who facilitates the import formalities.

#### Consignee:

Buyer/importer of the cargo.

#### Release to:

Party who receives the cargo.
