


How to Request Bill of Lading Release via www.Maersk.com


Request for Issue BL to Other Party & Request for Electronic Cargo Release (Telex Release)

Dear Valued Customer,

There will be 3 options "Electronic Cargo Release" for telex request, "Amend Bill of Lading", and "B/L Release" for BL issuance to other party.





Request for Electronic Cargo Release (Telex Release)


Electronic Cargo Release (ECR) will help you to request telex via website instead of requesting via e-mail or call. Customers only need to settle the payment of Telex Fee and don't have to surrender the OBL + LOI anymore. Request for ECR can be placed on a shipment from any cargo originating country. The restriction applies on some of the destination country and there will be notification as below so you unable to choose ECR.

① We don't offer Electronic cargo release for your Destination country. Please reach out to your local country office for more info.

This request can be made with below condition

- Logged in customer is the Transport Document Receiver (TDR)
- Final Original Bill of Lading has been issued.
- Customer have signed web print BL agreement.




Request for Issue to Other Party

This request can be made with below condition

- Logged in customer is the Transport Document Receiver (TDR)
- Draft/Verify Copy of Negotiable Bill and Non-Negotiable Bill that has been issued
- Final Sea Waybill that has been issued





• For Final Original BL that has been issued, customer should have signed Web Print BL Agreement.

Read the disclaimer carefully "By making this request via our website, you warrant that the above company will now be the lawful recipient of the goods and you further warrant, that if the bill of lading has been printed by you in accordance with a web printing agreement with Maersk, any such hard copies of the bill has been destroyed as per the terms of the web printing agreement".
